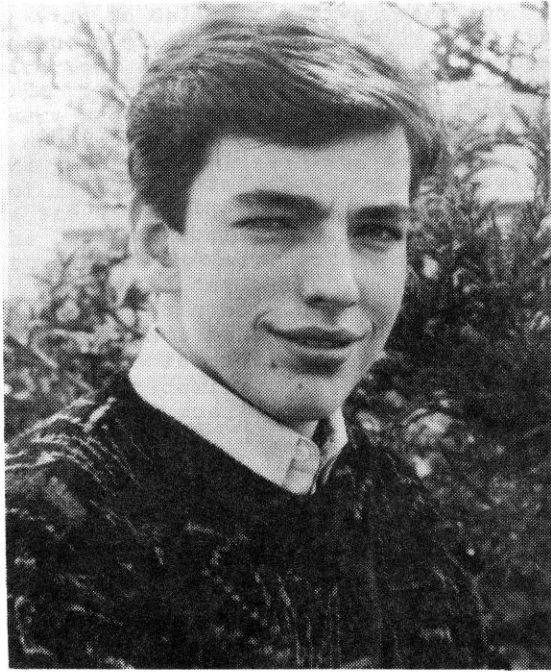

Jennifer Brawn (Maisie)

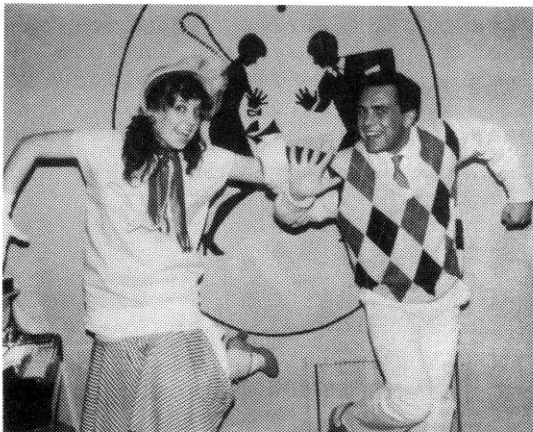
