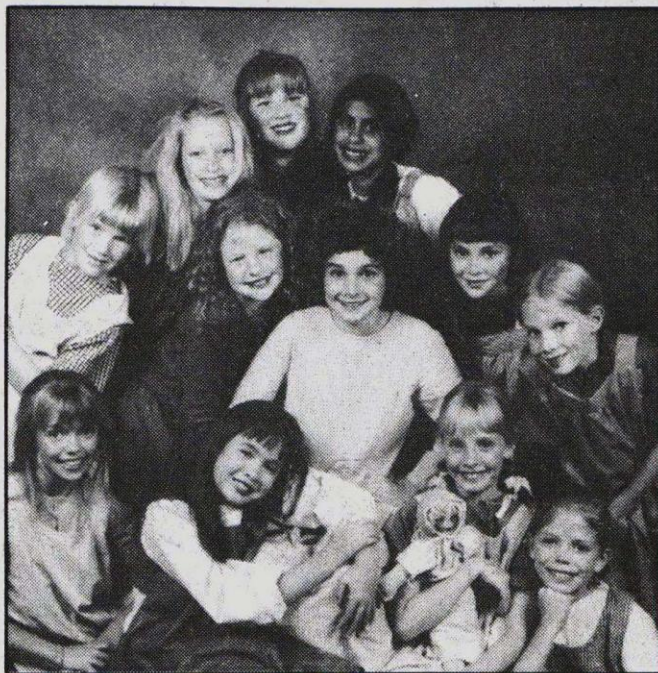

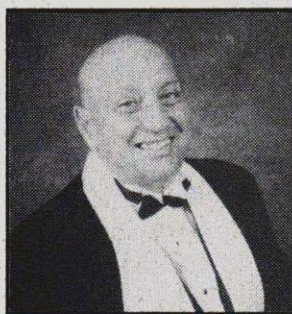

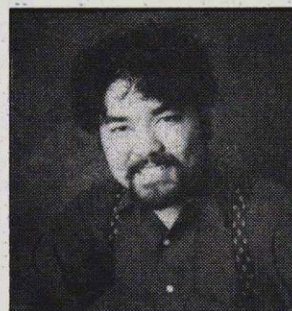
Production Staff and Featured Players
