In 1985, it was decided to change the name to South Valley Civic Theatre to expand the home base of our community theatre to include participants and patrons in Morgan Hill, Gilroy, Hollister, San Juan Bautista and our whole South Valley. Our season now is typically five shows including a show with a cast of children and another made up of teen performers. We generally do at least one musical and an adult comedy or drama.
