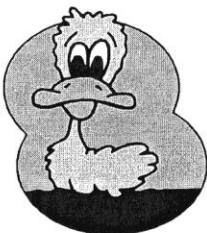
## THE SVCT PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

### **Donna Knippen**

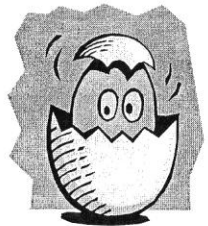
### **Her Grace**

### **Mark Ruiz**

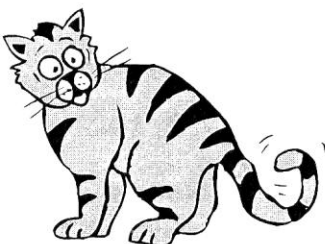
### **Goose, Fish, Elegy Chorus, Snowy**
