Director's Note

Plaza Suite is not your typical Neil Simon play. Yes, it has the snappy dialogue filled with one liners that is so characteristic of Simon's writing, but this show is really three very different one-act plays tied together by their setting in the Plaza Hotel in New York. Two acts are not classic comedic plots, but the third is "full frontal" Neil Simon comedy (always leave 'em laughing). This presents a particular challenge to actors and directors. How do you mix comedy in situations that are not, on the surface, inherently funny? It is what all the greatest writers do, they grind comedy against tragedy to heighten the two and examine the complexities of human relationships. Will the audience feel free to chuckle at something funny in a situation where the dramatic tension is building? As a director, that will tell me if we have succeeded or not. Plaza Suite contains some of Neil Simon's most inspired and poignant writing and these talented actors have worked hard to bring it to life. Enjoy!

Producer's Notes

Hotel suites played a large part in playwright Neil Simon's life as he traveled extensively writing and premiering plays in various cities. They had a lasting effect on him and prompted him to write four suite works – *Plaza Suite, California Suite, London Suite,* and Hotel Suite.

In planning for this production we decided to present *Plaza Suite*, Mr. Simon's first compilation of one-act plays sharing a common setting (The Plaza Hotel in New York City), and *California Suite*, which contains four one-act playlets, each giving us a glimpse of various groups of guests in the same suite at the Beverly Hills Hotel at different times of the same year. Each play brings us heartfelt, insightful, and sometimes madcap portraits of widely divergent couples with vastly different dilemmas. In them Mr. Simon brings an unmistakable taste of real life to the stage, making us believe and allowing us to relate. We are able to laugh heartily at ourselves and others without guilt.

Jonathan Bass—Marvin Michaels (California Suite) Bellhop (Plaza Suite) Jonathan is teacher at Del Buono Elementary School in Gilroy. He enjoys pretending he knows a little more about some things than his students. (He never fools them for long.) He especially enjoys playing pretend on stage. Kevin Heath—Terry (California Suite) Sam Nash (Plaza Suite)


