# THE TRADITION OF THE GYPSY ROBE

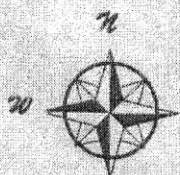

### Drew Jones – Seymour



### **Michael Lund – Bass (Feb. 22-23)**

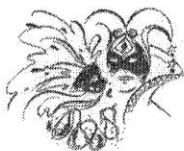


