

The Gypsy Robe

During each production, the Gypsy Robe is awarded to a member of the chorus for their contribution to the cast and the production. The "Gypsy" is the chorus member who most exemplifies the community spirit of the show. Recipients of the Gypsy Robe infuse the production with positive energy and goodwill. They provide a shining example of teamwork and dedication, and bring out the best in their fellow cast members and crew.

The Gypsy Robe is awarded on Opening Night. The wearer traditionally circles the stage counterclockwise three times to bring good fortune to the production and luck to the cast and crew. During the run of the show, the "Gypsy" is responsible for attaching a memento of the show to the robe, and returning it to the theatre on closing so that the tradition may carry on.

Andrea Borgia - Secretary, Dogpatch Citizen


