

A MESSAGE FROM THE SVCT PRESIDENT

Get ready for an interesting twist on the fairy tales you knew as a child!

Into The Woods was nominated to the Play Reading Committee and passed over many times. Often the junior version was considered for the teens but was rejected as it wasn't felt to be as rich a theater experience as the original. One of this musical's biggest challenges is the difficulty of Stephen Sondheim's vocal score. When considered for adults it was often eliminated out of concern that there wasn't enough talent in the region that could handle the vocals. This cast has done a beautiful job; the show has come together nicely.

Producers Nikki Tom and co-producer Trudy Parks put together a very experienced team for this show. Kathy Tom, director, loves this musical and has taken great care with the story. Terry Sodergren, vocal director, last directed vocals for SVCT's 1776. April Ouellette has choreographed adult, teen and children's shows with SVCT for over 10 years. Alan Chipman, music director, always does wonderful work with the orchestra when he directs. Speaking of the orchestra, Alan is leading a group of very talented musicians. We are very fortunate to have live music tonight.

The SVCT 2010-2011 Season has been announced: *Robin Hood and Friends* (children's musical); *Noises Off!* (an adult comedy), *Anything Goes* (teen musical), *Curtains* (adult musical comedy), and *Inherit the Wind* (large drama for all ages). Watch the SVCT website for details about the last show of the season, *The King and I*, as well as season ticket information.

The SVCT family is missing Becky Kaiser, a board member and early producer of this production. She recently lost her battle with colon cancer. Becky loved theater and co-produced seven shows. She managed costumes and props, worked backstage and in just about every other capacity.




