Dear Patrons,

Cole Porter, composer and lyricist for Anything Goes, had his first song on Broadway, "Esmeralda", in 1915 when he was 25 year old. That show and his second effort on Broadway were both flops. One listing of his "notable songs" totals 67. In 1937, at age 46, his legs were crushed in a horseback riding accident. He claimed to have written "At Long Last Love" while he was waiting for help, in pain; a pain he suffered for the rest of his life. I love that our teens got to know Porter's music through this through this show and they like it.

Producers, Terri Miles and Trudy Parks have worked very hard to shepherd this musical from planning to the stage. Janell Cummings, is directing for SVCT for the first time. She has directed in schools and at church, and volunteered backstage for SVCT. Alan Chipman, musical director, and Mitzie Imagawa, choreographer, have worked with the teens many times and always add creativity and interest to the music and dance.

SVCT's 2011-2012 Season will be announced on March 14<sup>th</sup> at the annual Member's Meeting. The invitation letters are in the mail.

SVCT depends on volunteers to produce shows like what you are seeing tonight. While volunteers do all of the hard work, the costs of theatrical rights, materials and utilities have increased. I know that these economic times have been difficult for many of you but if you appreciate live theater please support SVCT by buying a membership and/or advertising in our programs.
