When E. B. White published *Charlotte's Web* in 1952, I don't think he had any idea that his story would become a beloved children's book about the true meaning of friendship and unconditional love. Written after his first published book, "Death of a Pig," Charlotte appears to be inspired as a sort of apology to a real-life sick pig that White failed to save some years earlier. In other words, there is some reason to think he was simply making amends, soothing a guilty conscience. Of course, his story does so much more. In Charlotte, we see a generous and giving soul who sympathizes with the unjust fate awaiting Wilbur and who wants to do something about it, something that will make the world just a little bit better place, without any thought of personal gain. Yes, we could use a few more folks like that. Wilbur honors that friendship and proves a true and loyal friend himself by returning the gift of life and caring at the end of our story. Some pig. And let's not forget the "Don't judge a book by its cover" aspect of the story. Charlotte, a spider, is an unlikely hero, teaching us that real beauty and love can be found in the most unexpected times and places. These musings, of course, only scratch the surface of this cherished work.

Please join us in January for our teen production, "On the Town." This fun show is already cast and in rehearsal. It's so loaded with talent that you may forget you're watching high school "kids." In fact, I'm likely to catch some flack for using the "k" word. Sorry guys.

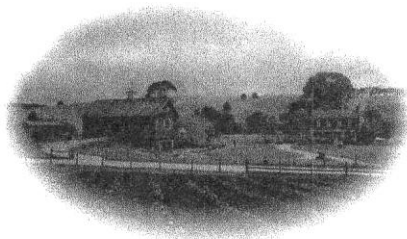

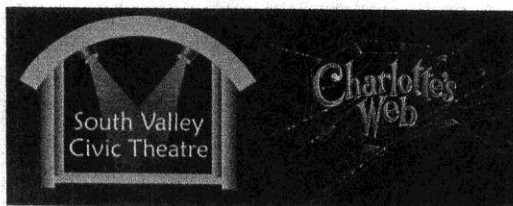

Megan Carrillo ~ *Lurvy*



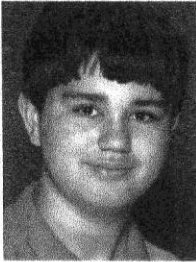

Maya Eulo ~ *Photographer & Uncle Pig*

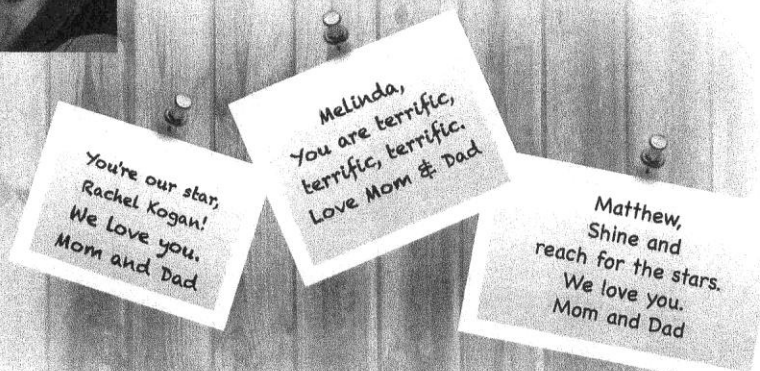

Brianna Pember ~ Townsperson & Fairgoer

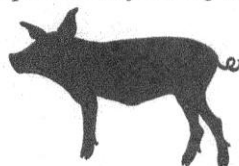
