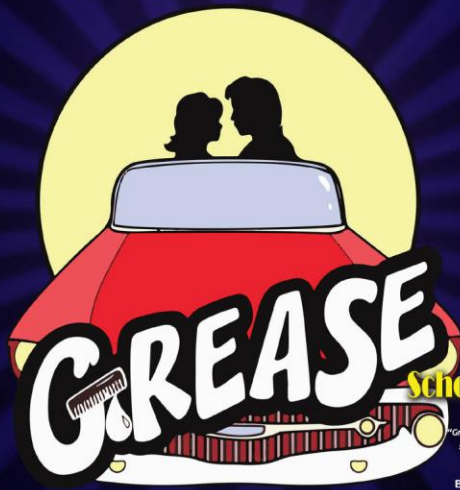

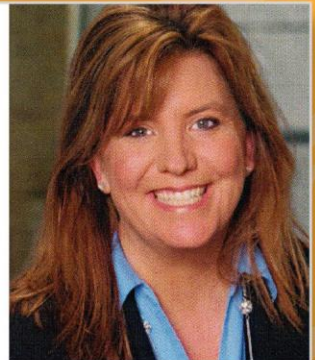

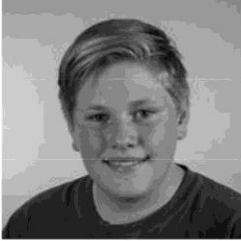

HAWK: To offer (something) for sale by calling out in the street

RUMINATE: To think deeply about something

SALAAM: A greeting in many Arabic-speaking countries meaning "peace."

SINBAD: A character in *One Thousand Nights*. Sinbad the Sailor recounts his adventures on seven voyages, which include shipwrecks, cannibals, and fantastical animals.

SULTAN: The historical name used in certain parts of the Middle East and North Africa for an absolute ruler.

TABBOULEH: Pronounced "tuh-boo-lee." A Middle Eastern dish made of bulgar (a whole wheat grain), tomatoes, parsley, mint, and onion. It is seasoned with olive oil, lemon juice, and salt.

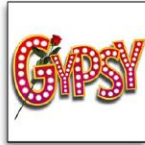

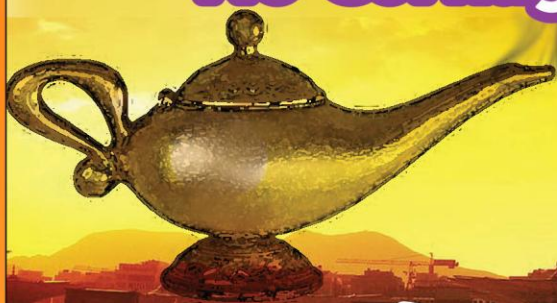
