Other favorite performing credits include Follies (Sally), They're Playing Our Song (Sonia), Merrily We Roll Along (Mary), The Diary of Anne Frank (Mrs. Van Daam), and City of Angels (Angel City 4). Diane has been singing professionally for over 40 years, and is looking forward to having even more time to do just that as retirement from her "day job" rapidly approaches! She thanks the incredibly gracious team here at Limelight, led by the incomparable Kevin Heath, for welcoming her back and making this journey into the life and music of Rosemary Clooney such a special one. Minna Rogers is thrilled to be involved in this wonderful show with this extraordinarily talented cast and staff. Minna teaches ballet, tap, and jazz on the Peninsula, and her choreography highlights include West Side Story (Pacifica Spindrift) and Evita (Sunnyvale Players). She has been seen on stage in roles such as Cassie in A Chorus Line, Mona in Dames at Sea, Jean in Brigadoon, and Maria in Sound of Music. Her next project is choreographing Grease for Sunnyvale Players this Fall.

A Note About the Show From Our Director

Everyone has a story. That's something I am frequently reminded of as I get to know the people with whom I cross paths in the various aspects of my own life. Often, we find ourselves only seeing what's on the surface, and forming our opinions and, sadly, judgments, based on that limited view. In our play, Rosie cries out, "I'm a person!" How often does each one of us long to be seen for all of the parts of us that go below the surface and make us deeply human? I think that's what the story we are about to tell you today is really all about. You will certainly leave this theatre knowing more about Rosie and the people who mattered to her and had an influence on her life, but I think you might also find some things in her story that you may recognize - either in yourself or in someone you know. The universality of the human condition is fascinating, and it is why the arts are so important. It is through artistic storytelling in all of its forms that we can come to know, understand and empathize with one another. And that is, after all, what this world needs more of. I am eternally grateful to Kevin Heath and Limelight for giving me this opportunity to work with a dream team of collaborators and artists to bring Rosie's story and her music into your life. My deepest gratitude and love especially go out to Michael Johnson and Michael Hirsch - I cannot imagine going through this journey with anyone else by my side. Lori and Annette - this show simply would not have happened without you, my forever friends. "When the angels ask me to recall the thrill of it all, then I will tell them -I remember you."

Rosemary Clooney (May 23, 1928 – June 29, 2002) came to prominence in the early 1950s with the song "Come On-a My House", which was followed by other pop numbers such as "Botch-a-Me", "Mambo Italiano", and "Tenderly". She also had success as a jazz vocalist. Clooney's career languished in the 1960s, partly due to problems related to depression and drug addiction, but revived in 1977, when her White Christmas co-star Bing Crosby asked her to appear with him at a show marking his 50th anniversary in show business. She continued recording until her death in 2002.

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
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
