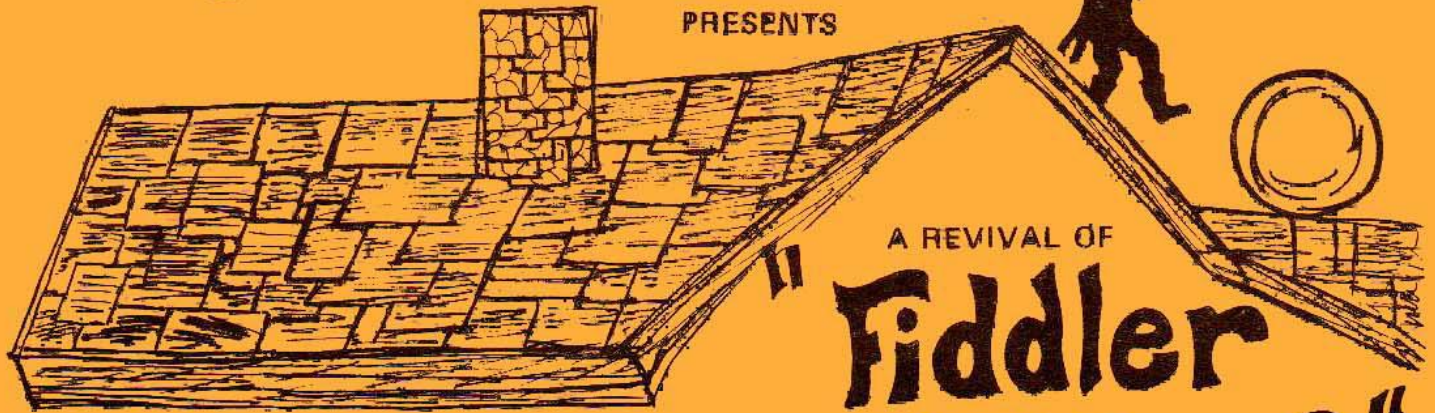

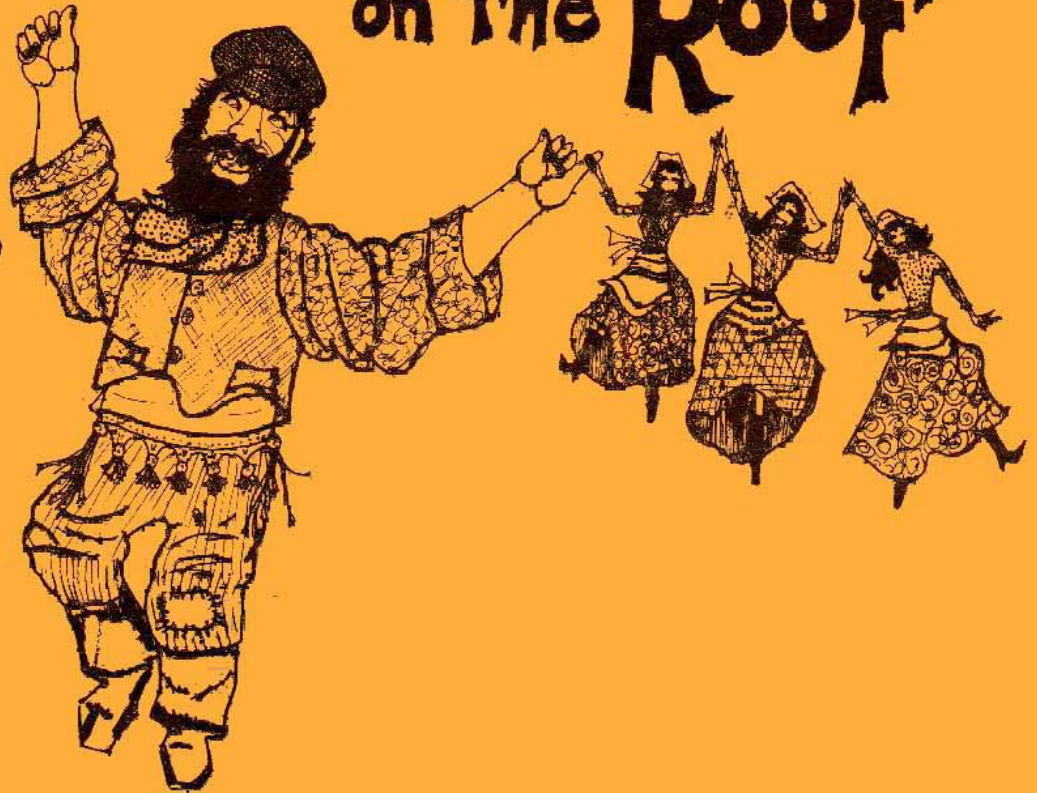

CHARLES-EDWARD SPOERRI (Tevye)- Charlie is returning to Gilroy to re-create the role he played in the 1972 GCT production of *Fiddler*. Now a member of Actor's Equity, Charlie has played Tevye in several productions, as well as other roles in dozens of musicals. He has appeared in several touring companies, and has played opposite Van Johnson, Ken Berry, and Jo Anne Worley.



PHIL ROBB (Motel)- Phil is making his debut on the Gilroy stage, having previously appeared as the Chief of Police in the Gilbert & Sullivan production, "*Pirates of Penzance*" at Westmont College in Santa Barbara. Phil is a talented vocal director, and has led several church and school choirs in the local area.



JAMES MEAD MAYA (Lzar Wolf/Tevye Understudy)- Jim is well known to local audiences and drama students alike. As Director of the Gilroy High School Theatre, he has guided hundreds of students interested in the stage, as well as having appeared in local productions of "*Sound of Music*" (as Capn. von Trapp), "*1776*" (John Adams), "*Odd Couple*" (Oscar), and "*The Crucible*" (John Proctor).



JANNINE CARRERA (Tzeitel)- Jannine was in GCT's first musical, "*Guys and Dolls*", and has since appeared in "*Cabaret*", "*Kiss Me Kate*", and "*Rodgers and Hart*", as well as the original production of *Fiddler* in 1972. Jannine, who teaches handicapped children, has also appeared as Luisa in "*The Fantasticks*" for Center Stage, and in "*Oklahoma!*" for San Jose Civic Light Opera.



CAROL MAYA (Golde)- Carol delighted GCT audiences this spring as Elvira in "*Blythe Spirit*", and has also appeared in "*Sound of Music*" with GCT, and "*Don't Start Without Me*" for Center Stage. Carol is a talented artist and potter, and her work is displayed locally.



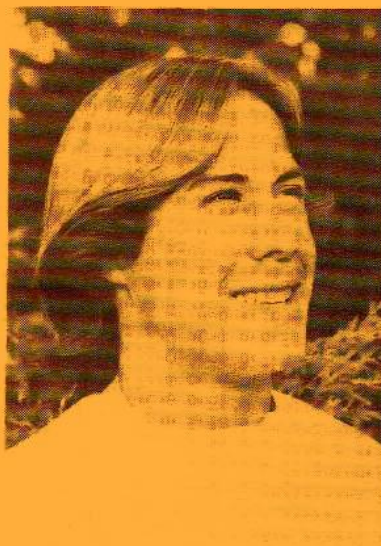
MADELIME LA PLANT (Yente)- A natural for the part of the lovable matchmaker and busybody, Madeline is appearing on stage for the first time in this production. A recent bride, Madeline is a retired nurse, and a graduate of Gavilan College, who is now working as a free-lance writer.



ROBERT D. FLANIGAN (Perchik)- A newcomer to Gilroy, Rob appeared in *Fiddler on the Roof* only last year in Vacaville where he played the role of Fyedka. A senior at Mt. Madonna High School, he has also appeared in Vacaville productions of *Jesus Christ Superstar*, and *Oklahoma*.



TERI GREEN (Hodel)- Teri is making her debut at GCT, but has been no stranger to the Gavilan College Theater, having appeared in *"The Hostage"*, *"Dark of the Moon"*, and as Miss Naroon in *"Red Dawg"*. She studied drama at Stanislaus State where she appeared in *Camelot*, and also was featured as Liat in *"South Pacific"* for Hollister Community Theatre.



GLEN ROSE (Fyedka)- A GCT "rookie", Glen has performed in *"South Pacific"* and *"My Sister Eileen"* in Hollister. A student of music, architecture, and computer technology, Glen is a former theatrical lighting technician who has spent many years in theatre and plans to spend many more.



LAURA YOUNGWERTH (Chava)- Laura has long been active in dramatic productions both at Gilroy High School and for Gilroy Community Theatre. She has previously appeared in GCT productions of *"Sound of Music"*, and *"Kismet"*, and appeared as Marian, the Librarian in the Gilroy Children's Musical Theater production of *"Music Man"*.



DEBBIE NELSON (Director-Choreographer)- Debbie's list of theatrical credits are staggering. She has been dancing in and choreographing shows since her childhood, and has choreographed many professional performers on the West Coast. Long active in San Jose Civic Light Opera, Debbie now runs the Academy for the Performing Arts in San Jose, with her musician husband, Richard.



CREIGHTON YIP (Musical Director)- Creighton has been directing the orchestra and the music for major GCT musicals since its inception over 10 years ago. A noted musician and instrumentalist, Creighton is a music instructor at Gilroy High School, and was the musical director of the original production of *Fiddler* by GCT in 1972.
