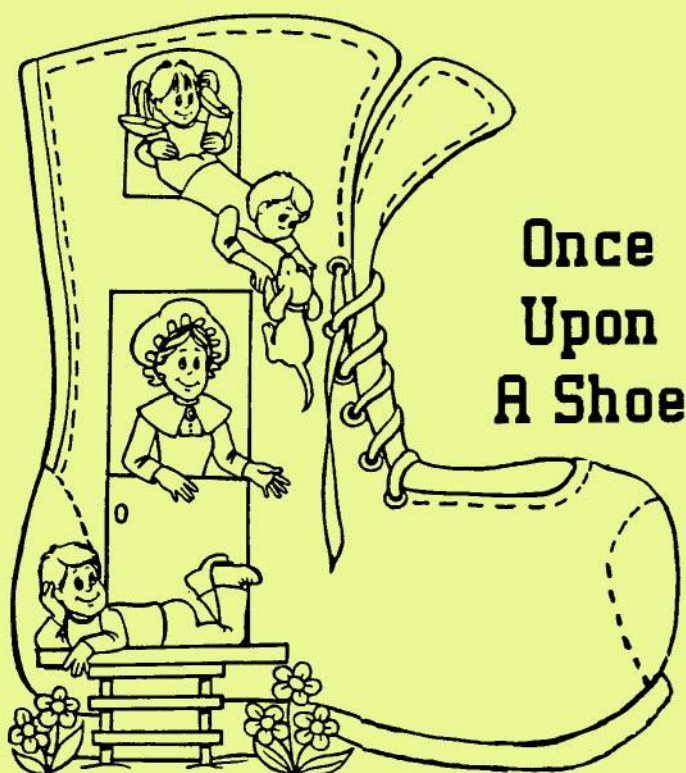

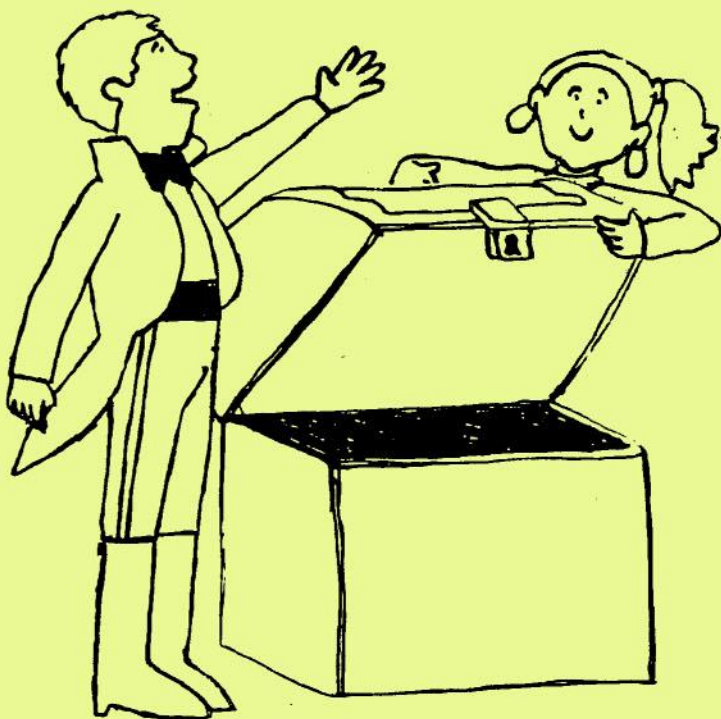

Two of last season's plays were an original work by a local author and a classic by Chekov. This year we begin with two non-musical plays by our Young Performers. The One Acts will return with new offerings in the fall and winter.
