

About the Cast







His mission was to rid the seas of pirates. Kidd's crew threatened mutiny if he did not turn to piracy. Kidd was forced to shoot one of the men to maintain control of his ship. Eventually Kidd did turn pirate, and began plundering ships up and down the Malabar coast. Unfortunately for Kidd, many of the ships that he had plundered belonged to the East India Company, who had him arrested as soon as he returned to America.

He was then taken to London, tried, and hanged in 1701.


