

A message from SVCT's President

SVCT began this season with the modern, whimsical show *The 25th Annual Putnam County Spelling Bee* offering our audiences something contemporary and groundbreaking. We decided to balance that as we close our 2012-2013 season with one of the most cherished classics of all shows in musical theater, *Fiddler On The Roof*.

Fiddler On The Roof is about the importance of tradition and values in a time of overwhelming uncertainty and change. It's about relationships between a man and his family, his community, and his God when relationships are challenged and fragile. It's also about a people's love for their fellow man and their birthplace at a time when inhumanity is all around them. It's about pride, oppression, dignity, and sorrow. While it is placed in a small Jewish village in Russia, it is really about all of us and takes place everywhere, with the challenges and themes as relevant today as in 1905 when the show is set.

As is the case with many famous shows, Fiddler got off to a difficult start. In 1953, a man named Arnold Perl put together a series of plays based on the stories of Sholem Aleichem including one called Tevye and his Daughters. Joseph Stein, who wrote the book for Fiddler believed that the story would make a good musical and introduced it to his collaborators, Jerry Bock and Sheldon Harnick. They showed a first draft to various producers who all said it was "too ethnic." It sat on the shelf until a few years later when they showed it to a new producer, Hal Prince, and a new director, Jerome Robbins who had just directed West Side Story. The show opened with tryouts in Detroit and Washington D.C. While it was successful, the critics again said it would have "limited appeal." Finally, it opened on Broadway in 1964 where the critics and audiences loved it, and it became the longest running musical on Broadway to that date, playing for 3,242 performances.

Fiddler went on to productions around the world. In it's first foreign production, the writer Joseph Stein recalled going to Japan to see the final rehearsals. The Japanese producer asked him, "Tell me, Mr. Stein, so they understand this show in America?" Stein, bewildered, asked him what he meant. "Because," he said, "it is so Japanese." Apparently it did not have the "limited appeal" the critics predicted.

We in SVCT take great pride in bringing a wide variety of theater to our area: from musical theater classics to wonderful, yet lesser known shows; from shows performed by the youth and teens of our community to our main stage productions. We hope you enjoy our productions and will look for opportunities to join our "family" on stage, back stage, or as members so we can continue our tradition of over 40 years of quality theater.




Terry Sodergren ~ Assistant Vocal Coach

The World of "Fiddler on the Roof"

Fiddler on the Roof is based on the writings of Shalom Aleichem, the pen name of Samuel Rabinowitz. Rabinowitz was born in the Ukraine in 1859, when Russia was still an empire. He lived in a shtetl, a small village like the fictitious town portrayed in Fiddler on the Roof. He wrote in Yiddish, the language of Eastern European Jews, describing the world in which he lived. His pseudonym, Shalom Aleichem, is a Hebrew and Yiddish greeting that means "peace be unto you." His most famous work was the story of Tevye the Dairyman and his five daughters, the inspiration for Fiddler on the Roof.

The world of Tevye is sometimes romanticized because the story is so charming. In fact, it takes place during a very dark time in Jewish history, when Russia was inflamed by a great deal of anti-Jewish propaganda, spread by Tsar Nicholas II. These lies created both fear and hatred of Jews, which led to violence in the form of pogroms, as mildly depicted in Fiddler's wedding scene. A pogrom is defined as a violent mob attack against Jews, their homes, properties, and synagogues, which was either encouraged or approved by the government or police.

The Jews of the shtetl managed to live a full Jewish life, in spite of persecution, poverty and fear. There was only Orthodoxy in the shtetl, although some young Jews were beginning to become familiar with the secular world, as portrayed by Perchik in Fiddler.

In the patrilineal society of the shtetl the father of the house ruled – or thought he did. The shtetl's rabbi guided every aspect of their lives. There was no separation between "religious" and secular life. Living life as a "good Jew" was of paramount importance. The centerpiece of living Jewishly was observing the Sabbath, the seventh day of the week, the day of rest.

Almost 90% of American Jews are descendants of the Jews of Eastern Europe. The ancestors of the Jews who immigrated to America weren't Russian, or Polish, or Hungarians. They were simply Jews.

Rabbi Israel served as a volunteer advisor to this production of Fiddler on the Roof. She is the spiritual leader of Congregation Emeth, 17835 Monterey Road, Morgan Hill.
