



The Tradition of the Gypsy Robe

Each SVCT production awards the "Gypsy Robe" to a chorus member who has made special contributions of time and energy towards the good of the show. The robe is presented to the recipient on opening night; the cast member puts on the robe and blesses the stage before the performance. It is then the duty of the recipient to affix to the robe a patch that signifies the show. The Gypsy Robe is then returned closing night to perform its duty for another show and carry on the tradition.

The Taiko Drum

The Taiko drum makes so powerful a sound that in ancient times it was said the boundaries of a Japanese village were determined by how far the sound of the village drum would carry. Villages had at least one drum and it was used for several forms of performance and communication. Some examples are a warning of danger, honoring ancestors, awakening the spirits of rain, calling the fisherman back from the sea, performance at both festivals and Japanese theater. It has been said that Taiko is the heartbeat of Japan. Taiko drumming may have been in existence for over 4000 years. There is much similarity of Japanese Taiko drumming to other Asian countries such as China and Korea. This influence is suggested from the Silk Road.

Sandoshin Taiko

Sandoshin Taiko, meaning "dragon mountain pass", was formed in 2000 as a means of blending traditional Japanese Taiko drumming with various martial art styles. This community group is affiliated with Renkishin Dojo in Morgan Hill. Ikuyo ("e-koo-yo") Conant serves as the Sensei ("sen-say") for the group. Virtually all Sandoshin Taiko members have constructed their own Taiko Drums. We feel that each member should put their time and energy into building a drum so they have a much deeper respect for Taiko. Almost all the drums that you see on the stage have been hand crafted by the group members.

Niseishin Daiko

Niseishin Daiko, meaning "second generation dragon", was formed in 2008 by Rebecca Shingai. This is Sandoshin Taiko's performing youth group and their Sensei is also Ikuyo Conant. These members are dedicated and a mix of middle and high school students.


