A Message from SVCT's President

The most famous Broadway musicals typically only live on the stage. Occasionally, one will have enough cross-over appeal to also become a movie. *Shrek* is exceptional in that there have been four movies, two Christmas specials, and a Halloween special. After all that, the book for the first movie was then used to create a new musical version for the stage, complete with a new score, new book, new lyrics, and our



favorite, familiar characters, including Shrek, Donkey, Princess Fiona and Lord Farquaad. We are excited to bring this crowd-pleasing story to the South Valley Civic Theatre stage.

SVCT produces five shows each season, including one by our teen performers. We believe that our teens, besides being talented, gain from this experience through teamwork, accepting responsibility, overcoming stage fright, and learning performing skills from our creative staff. In the case of *Shrek*, the story also contains many valuable lessons for the teens in both our cast and the audience.

It's a classic story: Shrek wants to find his place in the world but isolates himself in his swamp rather than suffering rejection by society because of his looks. Meanwhile, Fiona, unable to admit to others that by night she becomes an ogre, hides herself away before sunset. She even keeps her secret from Shrek, someone she actually loves and respects. She wants desperately to be accepted by the "right" people. Together they overcome their fears and find love and the confidence to be themselves.

The 2008 Broadway production of *Shrek* was the most complex Broadway show produced up until that time. It received a total of eight Tony Award nominations, including Best Musical, three acting awards, and the Tony Award for Best Costume Design. It ran for an impressive 441 performances and 37 previews.

Our next production will be our youth musical, *Seussical Jr.*, The fun of Dr. Seuss, plus some wonderful songs, promise this will be a family favorite. Opening night is April 24.

Enjoy the show and please consider joining our theatrical family for opportunities to be on stage, or back stage, or to become members. Help us continue our tradition of 45 years of quality theater.


Danielle Dokter


Isabel Hernandez


Christine Carrillo




