



Of South Valley Civic Theatre's six 2016 productions, two were specifically tailored to showcase our youth and teen performers. We offer youth and teen shows not just to put their talent on display, but because at SVCT we believe our teens gain from this experience through establishing teamwork, accepting responsibility, overcoming stage fright, and learning performing skills from our creative staff. As we begin 2017, our teens are performing one of our favorites, *Footloose*, with a story that has become newly relevant since it broke box office records in the 80's.

Throughout history, we have seen that, at a time of turmoil, fear, and suspicion, people will accept extraordinary steps from those in authority. The population will convince themselves that this "new normal" is necessary, losing their freedom in the process. In *Footloose*, we see this in microcosm in the town of Bomont, where a local tragedy is used by the town leadership to limit freedoms. The residents have come to accept the climate of fear and suspicion that pervades Bomont as an unavoidable part of their small-town life. It takes an outsider to shake the town out of its complacency.

Our next production is the adult comedy *Vanya and Sonia and Masha and Spike* by Christopher Durang. This delightful comedy was a Broadway hit, winning the Tony Award in 2013 for Best Play, the Drama Desk award for Outstanding Play, and the New York Drama Critics Circle Award for Best Play. It opens on April 21st and I am sure you will love it. For a terrific evening out, consider dinner at one of our wonderful downtown restaurants followed by this theatrical production.

Enjoy the show and please consider joining our theatrical "family" for opportunities to be on stage, backstage, or members so we can continue our tradition of over 48 years of quality theater.





What he isn't prepared for are the rigorous local edicts, including a ban on dancing instituted by the local preacher, determined to exercise the control over the town's youth that he cannot command in his own home. When the reverend's rebellious daughter sets her sights on Ren, her roughneck boyfriend tries to sabotage Ren's reputation, with many of the locals eager to believe the worst about the new kid. The heartfelt story that emerges is of a father longing for the son he lost and of a young man aching for the father who walked out on him. To the rockin' rhythm of its Oscar and Tony-nominated top 40 score (the soundtrack album reached number one on the Billboard charts and has sold over 15 million copies!) and augmented with dynamic new songs for the stage musical, FOOTLOOSE celebrates the wisdom of listening to young people, guiding them with a warm heart and an open mind.
