He also has play piano or keyboards in the orchestra pit for multiple shows. ### A Note About the Show From Our Director

I recently re-read the liner notes that are included in the original cast recording of The Last Five Years. There is a statement in there that really struck me. "The heart is not always ruled by honorable thoughts." I spent some time thinking through these words, and I've decided to take issue with them - particularly as they relate to the story of Cathy and Jamie. I don't think the heart is ruled by any kind of thought, honorable or dishonorable - particularly during the innocent phase of youth. I don't think there is anything dishonorable about the two characters and their relationship that we come to know in this show. When we are young and figuring out how to make our way in this life, we will inevitably find ourselves in unfamiliar territory and cross paths with people who stir up strong feelings inside of us that we have not experienced before. And when this happens, I think we allow ourselves to be guided, and perhaps even misguided, by the emotional tsunami that comes with this first love. There are the lucky few who are fortunate enough to connect with "the one" right out of the gate, but I think there are likely more of us who need to go through that first painful journey in order to learn how to love - how to love ourselves as well as someone else. And I think that is the essence of Cathy and Jamie's story. As we mature and, presumably, get a little wiser, I think we learn how to better balance the emotions of the heart with rational thoughts, and we become more adept at using both of these powerful forces together to make better choices and decisions. At least, that's something to strive for! And so let's go on this journey together, and get drawn into that wild ride of first love when emotions tend to rule over thoughts. In the words of Bette Davis in All About Eve, "Fasten your seatbelts. It's going to be a bumpy night."




# Limelight's Holiday Comedy: Nov/Dec 2018 Annual Fundraiser for Parkinson's Research
