Director's Note

Welcome,

The playwright does a remarkable job penning the broken world of the main character, Juliana, as well as putting her in the unique position of making her our tour guide through that chaos.

We do try and keep her realities sorted as best we can for you. But should you find yourself confused or lost at all during the performance, that's okay. So is Juliana. That is exactly the world of the play Juliana is living – confusing, non-linear, and (at times) broken.

What's tragic is that many of us may already be familiar with that feeling or someone who lives it daily. Here are some informative statistics of which you may not (though, tragically, far too many of you may) be aware:

- 1) Over 55 million people live with dementia worldwide.
- 2) Anywhere from 50% - 90% of cases globally are undiagnosed, depending on medical access.
- 3) 65% of dementia-related deaths are women.
- 4) By 2060 dementia cases are expected to double.

As always, we also try and keep our interpretation of the work and these characters' lives as honest as possible. So, for those who may find this piece upsetting or triggering, we apologize for your discomfort.

I am thankful to the cast and crew for all of their effort in this production. All have been remarkable. We hope you enjoy - and remember - the show.

About the Playwright: Sharr White

Sharr White is an acclaimed American playwright and screenwriter whose work spans Broadway, Off-Broadway, and television. His Broadway play *Pictures from Home* premiered in 2023 at Studio 54, and *The Other Place* was produced by Manhattan Theatre Club, earning Laurie Metcalf a Tony Award nomination. Other notable theatre work includes *The Snow Geese*.



In television, White was a writer and producer on Showtime's *The Affair*, created the Emmy Award-winning Netflix limited series *Halston*, and most recently served as an executive producer on Apple TV+ series *Palm Royale* and *Presumed Innocent*. Known for his sharp dialogue and emotional depth, White frequently explores family, identity, and the fragile nature of memory—central themes in *The Other Place*.

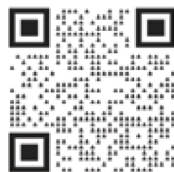

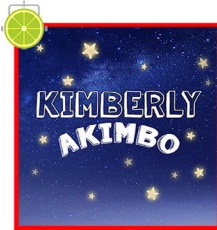
